

Minutes for AATL Board Meetings 11/30/2011 & 12/4/2011

1. **Treasurer's Report** (through 11/27/2011) Income=\$14,700.00, Expenses=\$10,881.38

2. Proposed changes for 2012

- a. Reduced registration fee (\$12 total per team, \$3 of which goes to AATL), and teams pay their own way to championships (Unanimously approved with vote by Board).
- b. First and Second place teams provide championship info/fees to avoid not sending team to championships (3 in 2011).
- c. Free registration to captains – “2 strikes” or violations will result no free captain registration for a person for 1 year. Strikes include rules violations. A single “serious” strike would also result in no free registration. Typical “serious strike” examples include playing people not on roster, playing matches later than scheduled, not complying with make-up match rule, using Out-of-State players without prior approval, championship team dropout after registration, or not getting information in on time. Basically, the AATL should not provide a Captain with the privilege of free registration if he/she doesn't perform the duties which are published at the end of all rules issued. Captain must attend preseason captain's meeting to get free registration.

3. FunFreeze Tournament

- A. Only Fall-for-Fun players get free entry, as opposed to all captains during the year since we paid for all local league captain registrations in 2011. Others to pay \$40 for one event, \$60 for two. \$15 for dinner fee.
- B. All hard court for planning. Will use clay if they are up. If there are weather/court issues, first round losers will only get a second match instead entering a Loser's bracket draw.
- C. Dates to be 1/13-15.
- D. Players may compete using beginning of year 2011 rating, or new end of year rating for 2012 if lower (CSRATA Early Start Ratings are not applicable).
- E. May enter a maximum of two events. If playing in two events, must be at same NTRP (e.g., singles 3.5 and doubles 3.5), or type (2 singles or 2 doubles but not singles and doubles at different NTRP).
- F. Draws planned are 2.5-4.0+ Singles and Doubles for Men and Women. As done in the Fall, 4.5 man may combine with a 3.5 for an 8.0 combination playing in the 4.0 Men's doubles division. Max doubles combination for women is 8.5.
- G. Board tasks:
