Fall 2008 Singles League Rules

Rules:

1. Weather permitting, at least two of 3 positions should start at regularly scheduled match time.
2. Individual matches not started at scheduled time may be played early, or up to 6 days after. If not played before 6 days are up, the match will be entered in Tennislink as a double default.
3. Defaults: the only reason for defaults is in the case of a no-show.
4. Play 3rd set tie-break in lieu of a third set.
5. Home team supplies the balls.
6. Visiting team captain should be notified of surface for the positions prior to the match.
7. Captains are encouraged to let each other know who will be playing ahead of time to permit desired match-ups between competitors. If a person wants to play someone in particular, let them play. If someone wants to avoid a player, too bad!!!! Get your butt kicked by the player you are trying to avoid, and move better luck next match!
8. Seven players maximum per team.

Based on the large number of 3.0-3.5 women, and 3.5-4.0 Men, line-ups shall be made using following NTRP/position combinations.

NOTE: To avoid defaults a 3.0 Male may play up to the #2 position if his opponent is a 3.5. There should be no matches between players with a rating differential >0.5.

Ladies:

- #1: NTRP 3.5-4.0
- #2: NTRP 3.0-3.5
- #3 NTRP 2.5-3.0

Men:

- #1: NTRP 4.0
- #2: NTRP 3.5-4.0
- #3: NTRP 3.0-3.5
